

## ***Waitlist & Deposit***

**We work off a Master Waitlist. Since we cannot guarantee what each litter will produce in color, gender or number of pups. We do not assign families to a particular litter. Once a litter is born we will go down the list and you will have the option to be put on that litter or wait or a later litter.**

Please feel free to contact us prior to submitting an application to answer any questions you may have about our Doodles or our program. Once the application has been submitted and approved, we will add your name to our master waiting list. The master list will go in order of date the application was received.

Once a litter is born, and we know how many pups, we will send out an email to the families on our waitlist starting at the top and working our way down the list until the litter is full. At that time you will have 5 days to place your deposit to hold your spot on that litter. If a deposit is not received we will move further down our waitlist. The email will have all the details about the litter, with date of birth and go home dates, how many of each gender, payment information etc. We will also set up a separate link where you can view weekly photos & videos of the pups.

Puppies will be available to choose when they are around 6-7 weeks of age. The puppy picks will be in the order your application was received and your name is on the wait list. We will contact you by phone, text or e-mail, so please keep your contact information current. You may remain on the master list up to 2 years. If you pass on any litter and prices change before the next chance to choose, you will be charged the new price. If after 2 attempts to contact you and you do not respond to our email or phone call, your name will be removed off our wait list.

Since COVID19 we have had to change the way we are doing things in regards to visitation. For our safety, your safety and the health & safety of our puppies we are no longer allowing visitation in our home where the pups will be raised.

Please understand that we are a small in home breeder and do not have a kennel facility that is available for visitation. With daily requests to visit each week we just cannot handle the interruptions to our home life or the care of our puppies. Our breeding dogs do not live in our home but live as loving family pets with their Guardians. At present there is only one breeding dog that lives under our roof full time along with 3 of our older Pet Labradoodles. Parvo virus is a real threat to the lives of young puppies that are not fully vaccinated. Canine Parvo Virus is a deadly communicable disease. It is transferred on shoes, clothes, and hands and can easily be picked up and carried in our home without you knowing that you have been exposed! So please understand about our no visitor policy, in regards to the Parvo virus and now the COVID19, it is for the safety and well-being of our family your family and puppies!.
